Description

Children are invited to record a video where they speak to adults and reveal their fears and worries about the future of the planet, but also their hope and willingness to make it a better place. The video is addressed to both adults in general and authorities.

Target group

Children up to 13 years of age from any school, association, or group.

Goals

- Promote a worldwide action spearheaded by children to raise awareness of environmental issues and the future of our planet.
- Encourage people who live in your area and local and international authorities to be more sensitive to environmental issues

Activity

1. Record a video (max length, 3 minutes):

Give voice to your fear and hope for a better world (use your mother tongue).

Below are some starting points:

- What is happening to our environment?
- How do environmental changes affect us?
- How do environmental changes affect the animals?
- How do you feel about that?
- What do you wish for the future?

2. Post your video on Youtube with the hashtag #UMFYC

- Ask permission to post your video on Youtube.com to your parents or legal guardians
- Remember to enter the hashtag "#UMFYC" in the video's title.

3. Send us your link

4. Your video will be added to the website.
