International Essay Contest

Description

Participants should write and submit an essay to the International Essay Contest, which promotes the culture of peace and sustainable development. The contest nurtures imagination in young people and promotes their proposals.

Essays must conform with the specific topic given (every year a new topic is chosen). Your insights and efforts may really make a difference in the world.

The activity is promoted by [Goi Peace Foundation](#) and [Living Peace International](#).

Target group

Children and kids up to 25 years of age from any school, association, or group.

Goals

- Have a deeper understanding of peace; help children and youth to express their thoughts through writing.
- Encourage the participants to offer solutions to the problems that hinder peace and be protagonists of the change they want to see in the world.

Activity

Be creative and write your essay. Every year a new topic is given.

- We have two categories of participants:
a) Children (up to 14 years), b) Youth (15-25 years)

The essays must be written in one of the following languages: English, Spanish, French, German, and Japanese. Digital or printed formats are accepted. They must be written by one author only.

NB. If you somehow represent a class or group, you can submit a collection of essays, giving your name and personal details, and a list of the participants, including their names and age.

- First, second, third ranked and honourable mentions will be awarded a prize.
