## Activity

- Every year we have a new theme we can work on.  
Artworks can be painted or drawn by hand on paper or cardboard. Recommended size:  
5" x 7" inch  
12.7 x 17.7 cm
- In order not to be disqualified, every child or kid must create her artwork on her own.
- We have four age categories. Every participant can submit one artwork only.  
**Category One:** 5 – 7 year olds  
**Category Two:** 8 – 10 year olds  
**Category Three:** 11 – 13 year olds  
**Category Four:** 14 – 16 year olds
- Those willing to take part in the exhibition [must register on the Peace Pal International website.](#)

The artworks can be submitted in two ways:

Third Place - 8" Desktop Peace Pole

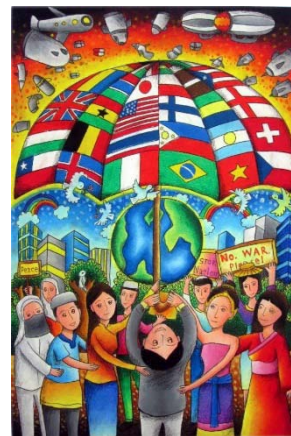
Finalists - Several Certificates and Prizes will be awarded
