



#Umbrellas4Peace

Description

This is an initiative of the American artist Matt Lamb, who, after the 11 September attacks on the Twin Towers in New York, started a workshop to help children who had lost their parents in the attack, proposing to each of them to express their feelings through colours and art by painting umbrellas. This project has multiplied in different parts of the world.

The initiative is promoted by Mimos para tu Ojos and Living Peace International

Participants: Children, young people and adults, from schools, youth groups and associations

Goals:

- To promote bonds of trust and of reciprocity among the participants
- To link the promotion of peace and artistic activity
- To develop creativity
- To express one's commitment to peace through art
- To sensitise society to the value of peace

Activities:

1- To promote with the class, with the group, a reflection on a value, a feeling, a sentence of the Dice, a wish related to peace and how to express it creatively

2- To paint umbrellas with a colourful peace mandala or any other expression reproducing the reflection made

3- Umbrellas can be painted alone or in pairs, agreeing on the design that best represents the commitment or desire for peace

4- Where possible, organise a Peace March through the city or neighbourhoods and/or

5- Organise an exhibition with the different Peace Umbrellas
